### Conditions of Entry:

- This is a **non-graded** event and is run under the current (2019) ESNZ GR's, VR's & ESNZ Rules for Dressage. All riders must be Full, Introductory or Casual ESNZ members. Horses and ponies may be un/registered (any grade). No grading points will be awarded in any class at this event.
- Direct **queries** to Ann Webster at [a.webster@xtra.co.nz](mailto:a.webster@xtra.co.nz) or 021 172 2740.
- Riders are to **wear allocated back numbers** when working or riding their horse/pony. Please collect from the office on morning of the show. Remember to return before you leave the grounds.
- Jackets and plaiting are not required** as per Article 479 in ESNZ Dressage Rule Book for non-graded competitions. Tidy dress, approved safety helmet and boots are to be worn.
- Championship** points will be awarded to combinations up to 10<sup>th</sup> place. Combinations must compete in all tests at the same level to be eligible for the Championship. In the event of a tie the highest average score will be awarded the Championship. If there is still a tie the highest score for the last test will be awarded the Championship.
- Official start time** is 2pm Saturday prior to the event. This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all ESNZ GR's and ESNZ Dressage Rules. Note DNZ Rule 477 prohibited gear is not allowed from the time of arrival at the event.

7. **Official finish time** will be 60 minutes after the completion of the last class or 60 minutes after the completion of presentations, whichever is the later.
8. **Protests and complaints** must be lodged in writing within 60 minutes of the official finish time, including a fee of \$50.00
9. Please advise **scratchings** prior to the event via Equestrian Entries/ My Entries or via Ann Webster on show day.
10. **Fees refunded:** 100% of Ground Levy & Yards fees and 50% of Class Entry fees refunded only if a Doctor or Vet certificate is provided within 7 days of the show.
